Before and After School Supervision

School District staff supervision is provided 15 minutes before the morning bell, and 15 minutes following dismissal. Bus students are supervised by school staff once riders arrive at school, and while awaiting pick up at the end of the day. Daycare providers are responsible for the children in their care at both pick up and drop off times. Children **must** be supervised by a parent or caregiver outside of school supervision times. Please do not leave your child to play unattended on the playground before and after school as they are not supervised by school staff. Thank you for your help with this safety issue.

Parking Lot Reminders

Our through lane is intended for moving traffic at drop off and pick up times. If parents are escorting children to and from their class line ups, cars must be parked in a stall or on the street and not in the through lane. Thank you for your consideration.
