**Morning Arrival:** Students are asked to line up at their line ups at the 8:35am warning bell and should not be at school before 8:30am unless they are at Happy Campers or on a bus. We have minimal supervision outside in the morning and will be asking all bus students to stay in the playground area before the warning bell.

**Late Arrivals:** Students arriving after the bell must check in at the office. Thank you parents for checking in and saying goodbye to your student at the office. Students should be comfortable making their way to their classroom independently and if not, Ms. Phipps or another staff member will walk them to their classroom.

**Early Pick-ups for appointments:** Please email your child's teacher to advise them of the date and time of the pick up and make sure to sign them out of the office when you come to pick them up. Students in Kindergarten, Grade 1 and 2 will be outside playing from 11:48 to 12:28. Students in Grades 3, 4 or 5 will be outside from 12:28 to 1:08

**Illness**: If your child is sick please keep them home as we are working hard to keep our staff and student population healthy this year.

**Parking and Traffic:** Please refrain from driving vehicles in the bus lane. District buses need to pick up and drop off on a schedule. There is no available parking in the staff lot by the playground and there are reserved spots for staff in the main lot. Thank you for keeping these clear as our itinerant staff come and go throughout the day. Thank you for not parking on Blueberry Lanes as that is a private road.

<u>Terry Fox Run:</u> Our Terry Fox Run is on Friday, September 22nd. It will start around 1:15pm and parents are welcome to attend.
